Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Labor. Public Hearing 03/03/95. House: Minority OTP-AM Accepted 05/11/95, Adhere to Engrossment 05/18/95; Senate: Majority ONTP Accepted 05/17/95, Insist on Majority ONTP 05/24/95. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 05/24/95.
