House: Majority ONTP Accepted 05/18/95, Adhere to Majority ONTP 05/30/95; Senate: Minority OTP-AM Accepted 05/10/95, Insist on Engrossment 05/23/95. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 05/30/95.
