An Act to Require That a Vacancy in a County Office Be Filled by an Appointee from the Same Political Party. Presented by Senator FERGUSON of Oxford; Cosponsored by Senators: BEGLEY of Lincoln, MICHAUD of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 04/26/95. Majority OTP Accepted 05/30/95. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 06/14/95, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 245.
