An Act to Fund Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) by Increasing the Tobacco Tax by 1.5 Mills. (BY REQUEST). Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 05/08/95. House: Re-refer to Appropriations and Financial Affairs 05/18/95, Insist on Re-reference 05/25/95; Senate: Indefinite Postponement 05/24/95, Adhere to Indefinite Postponement 05/30/95. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 05/30/95.
