Original Title: An Act to Amend the Dispositional Alternatives for Juveniles Adjudicated to Have Committed Gross Sexual Assault upon 2 or More Child Victims. New Title: An Act Concerning Juveniles Who Have Been Adjudicated to Have Committed the Juvenile Crime of Gross Sexual Assault. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 26.)
