An Act to Prohibit the Photographing or Videotaping of Jury Deliberations. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 27.) Presented by Representative LIBBY of Buxton; Cosponsored by Representatives: ADAMS of Portland, BARTH of Bethel, CAMPBELL of Holden, DEXTER of Kingfield, HARTNETT of Freeport, JOYNER of Hollis, LaFOUNTAIN of Biddeford, LANE of Enfield, LAYTON of Cherryfield, LEMKE of Westbrook, LUMBRA of Bangor, NASS of Acton, O'NEAL of Limestone, PLOWMAN of Hampden, ROBICHAUD of Caribou, UNDERWOOD of Oxford, WHEELER of Bridgewater, Senators: HANLEY of Oxford, RAND of Cumberland.
