RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Ensure that the Composition of the Legislature Reflects the Socio-economic Makeup of the Population of the State. Presented by Representative PERKINS of Penobscot; Cosponsored by Senator KILKELLY of Lincoln and Representatives: GIERINGER of Portland, JONES of Bar Harbor, LEMKE of Westbrook, LEMONT of Kittery, MacDOUGALL of North Berwick, PIEH of Bremen, SKOGLUND of St. George, VEDRAL of Buxton. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. Public Hearing 02/19/97. Final Disposition: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 04/30/97.
