Presented by Senator LIBBY of York; Cosponsored by Senator MacKINNON of York, Representatives: GERRY of Auburn, GOODWIN of Pembroke, MACK of Standish, UNDERWOOD of Oxford, JOYNER of Hollis, McALEVEY of Waterboro, WATERHOUSE of Bridgton. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 03/21/97. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 05/15/97.
