LD 580 / HP0430

An Act Relating to the Designation of Species As Endangered or Threatened. Presented by Representative FISK of Falmouth; Cosponsored by Senator RAND of Cumberland and Representatives: BULL of Freeport, OTT of York, SAXL of Portland, SHIAH of Bowdoinham, TRUE of Fryeburg, USHER of Westbrook, Senators: ABROMSON of Cumberland, MILLS of Somerset. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. Public Hearing 02/28/97. House: Indefinitely Postponed 05/12/97; Senate: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 05/14/97. Final Disposition: Died in Concurrence 05/14/97.
