An Act to Require Full State Funding of the Maine Tree Growth Tax Law. Presented by Representative BUNKER of Kossuth Township; Cosponsored by Senator RUHLIN of Penobscot and Representatives: BARTH of Bethel, CLUKEY of Houlton, DEXTER of Kingfield, HATCH of Skowhegan, KONTOS of Windham, NICKERSON of Turner, WHEELER of Bridgewater, Senator: MICHAUD of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 02/26/97. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 03/18/97.
