An Act to Allow the Courts to Suspend the Drivers' Licenses of Individuals Convicted of Civil Offenses Who Fail to Pay Their Fines within the Time Limits Ordered by the Court. Presented by Representative GOOLEY of Farmington; Cosponsored by Senator BENOIT of Franklin and Representatives: BUNKER of Kossuth Township, CARLETON of Wells, CLARK of Millinocket, DESMOND of Mapleton, DEXTER of Kingfield, JOY of Crystal, KERR of Old Orchard Beach, O'BRIEN of Augusta. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 04/10/97. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 03/20/98.
