LD 1266 / HP0923

An Act to Require the Deputy Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to be Appointed by the Governor and Confirmed by the Senate. Presented by Representative UNDERWOOD of Oxford; Cosponsored by Senator HALL of Piscataquis and Representatives: CROSS of Dover-Foxcroft, GOODWIN of Pembroke, PERKINS of Penobscot, TRUE of Fryeburg, WATERHOUSE of Bridgton. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. Public Hearing 04/02/97. House: Indefinitely Postponed 04/30/97; Senate: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 05/01/97. Final Disposition: Died in Concurrence 05/01/97.
