An Act to Implement Changes in the Maine Income Tax Laws. Presented by Representative TUTTLE of Sanford; Cosponsored by Representatives: BUCK of Yarmouth, GAGNON of Waterville, LEMONT of Kittery, MORGAN of South Portland, ROWE of Portland, TRIPP of Topsham, Senator: RUHLIN of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 03/26/97. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 04/14/97.
