An Act to Ensure Integrity in Government by Prohibiting Contributions when the Legislature Is in Session. Presented by Representative DAVIDSON of Brunswick; Cosponsored by President LAWRENCE of York and Representatives: BRUNO of Raymond, ETNIER of Harpswell, KONTOS of Windham, MITCHELL of Vassalboro, SAXL of Portland, TRUE of Fryeburg, TUTTLE of Sanford, Senator: DAGGETT of Kennebec. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 04/30/97. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 05/15/97.
