An Act to Authorize a Bond Issue to Assist Small Businesses in Improving Accessibility for Individuals with Disabilities and to Provide Loans to Individuals with Disabilities. Presented by Senator JENKINS of Androscoggin; Cosponsored by Senators: NUTTING of Androscoggin, PARADIS of Aroostook, RAND of Cumberland, RUHLIN of Penobscot, TREAT of Kennebec. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. Public Hearing 04/14/97. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 05/07/97.
