Presented by Representative SAXL of Portland; Cosponsored by Representatives: ETNIER of Harpswell, KONTOS of Windham, LEMONT of Kittery, SPEAR of Nobleboro, TRIPP of Topsham, Senators: MILLS of Somerset, PINGREE of Knox, RUHLIN of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 05/14/97. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 05/21/97.
