Resolve, Directing the Department of Labor to Transfer Appropriate Functions and Positions to the Office that Houses the Fort Kent Employment Security Office. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative BELANGER of Wallagrass; Cosponsored by Senator PARADIS of Aroostook and Representatives: AHEARNE of Madawaska, BARTH of Bethel, LEMKE of Westbrook, MACK of Standish, SIROIS of Caribou, TESSIER of Fairfield, Senators: CAREY of Kennebec, JENKINS of Androscoggin. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Labor. Public Hearing 05/09/97. Final Disposition: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 05/20/97.
