An Act Directing the Department of Transportation to Conduct the Necessary Studies and to Construct an East-west Highway. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative HATCH of Skowhegan; Cosponsored by Senator MILLS of Somerset and Representatives: DRISCOLL of Calais, GERRY of Auburn, MERES of Norridgewock, SAMSON of Jay, SAXL of Bangor. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. Public Hearing 05/12/97. Final Disposition: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 05/23/97.
