LD 1860 / HP1312

An Act to Authorize Hancock County to Hold a Referendum Election in November 1997 on a Bond Issue of \$6,000,000 to Construct a New Jail and to Provide Necessary Renovations to the Courthouse to Comply with State Mandates. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative POVICH of Ellsworth; Cosponsored by Senator GOLDTHWAIT of Hancock and Representatives: BIGL of Bucksport, BUNKER of Kossuth Township, JONES of Bar Harbor, LAYTON of Cherryfield, PERKINS of Penobscot, PINKHAM of Lamoine, VOLENIK of Brooklin, Senator: RUHLIN of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. Public Hearing 05/12/97. Majority (OTP-AM) Accepted 05/23/97. Amended by: CA H-586. Final Disposition: Emergency Enacted, Signed 06/09/97, P & S LAWS, Chapter 40.
