An Act to Authorize the Public Utilities Commission to Establish Reasonable Registration and Reporting Requirements and to Study Market Power Issues Associated with Electric Industry Restructuring. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.)
