Resolve, Requiring the State to Reimburse Towns for the Construction of Salt and Sand Storage Facilities. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative RINES of Wiscasset; Cosponsored by Representatives: GREEN of Monmouth, HONEY of Boothbay, KASPRZAK of Newport, PIEH of Bremen, SAVAGE of Union, Senators: MILLS of Somerset, NUTTING of Androscoggin, PINGREE of Knox. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. Public Hearing 02/02/98. Final Disposition: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 02/25/98.
