Presented by Representative TOWNSEND of Portland; Cosponsored by Representatives: BERRY of Livermore, KERR of Old Orchard Beach, LEMAIRE of Lewiston, MITCHELL of Portland, PIEH of Bremen, POULIN of Oakland, ROWE of Portland, STEVENS of Orono. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. Public Hearing 02/11/98. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 03/11/98.
