Presented by Representative DESMOND of Mapleton; Cosponsored by Senator PARADIS of Aroostook and Representatives: BELANGER of Wallagrass, BELANGER of Caribou, CLUKEY of Houlton, KNEELAND of Easton, Senator KIEFFER of Aroostook. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 02/23/98. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 03/25/98.
