An Act to Enhance Home-based Services for Maine's Elderly. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative KERR of Old Orchard Beach; Cosponsored by Senator PARADIS of Aroostook and Representatives: BERRY of Livermore, BROOKS of Winterport, KANE of Saco, LEMAIRE of Lewiston, O'NEIL of Saco, PIEH of Bremen, TOWNSEND of Portland, Senator MITCHELL of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. Public Hearing 02/11/98. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 03/11/98.
