An Act to Allow a Tax Refund for Used Business Equipment Purchased and Used in Maine. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Senator PARADIS of Aroostook; Cosponsored by Senator KIEFFER of Aroostook, Representative AHEARNE of Madawaska. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 02/18/98. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 03/11/98.
