An Act to Allow Recognition of Private Schools with Outstanding Residential Counseling Programs. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative SNOWE-MELLO of Poland; Cosponsored by Senator MITCHELL of Penobscot and Representatives: MacDOUGALL of North Berwick, MACK of Standish, MUSE of South Portland, PIEH of Bremen, WINGLASS of Auburn. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services. Public Hearing 02/09/98. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 02/23/98.
