Presented by Representative MITCHELL of Vassalboro; Cosponsored by Representatives: CAMPBELL of Holden, DONNELLY of Presque Isle, KERR of Old Orchard Beach, KONTOS of Windham, LOVETT of Scarborough, Senators: MICHAUD of Penobscot, RAND of Cumberland.
