An Act to Grant the Joint Standing Committee Having Jurisdiction over Criminal Matters the Authority to Review the Appointments of the Commissioner of Public Safety and the Chief of the State Police. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative POVICH of Ellsworth; Cosponsored by Senator MURRAY of Penobscot and Representatives: BUNKER of Kossuth Township, FRECHETTE of Biddeford, JONES of Greenville, McALEVEY of Waterboro, MUSE of South Portland, PEAVEY of Woolwich, WHEELER of Bridgewater, Senator MITCHELL of Penobscot.
