An Act to Create a Maine Children's Trust Fund Registration Plate. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative KONTOS of Windham; Cosponsored by Representatives: COLWELL of Gardiner, MAILHOT of Lewiston, O'BRIEN of Augusta, PIEH of Bremen, TAYLOR of Cumberland, Senators: LONGLEY of Waldo, AMERO of Cumberland, RAND of Cumberland.
