An Act to Encourage Adoptions and Reduce the Number of Children in Foster Care in the State. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative BRAGDON of Bangor; Cosponsored by Representatives: KANE of Saco, MADORE of Augusta, QUINT of Portland, Senator PARADIS of Aroostook. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 02/25/98. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 03/18/98.
