An Act to Amend the Laws Regarding Intellectual Property Rights. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative DONNELLY of Presque Isle; Cosponsored by Representatives: KONTOS of Windham, TESSIER of Fairfield, VEDRAL of Buxton, Senators: AMERO of Cumberland, BENNETT of Oxford, CATHCART of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 02/25/98. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 03/18/98.
