An Act to Allow a Municipality to Request a Joint Check from the Maine Residents Property Tax Program in the Event of Nonpayment of Taxes. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Senator LIBBY of York; Cosponsored by Representative VEDRAL of Buxton and Representatives: BUCK of Yarmouth, CIANCHETTE of South Portland, JOYNER of Hollis, McALEVEY of Waterboro. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 03/18/98. Final Disposition: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 03/24/98.
