An Act to Establish a Children's Bureau within the Executive Department to Serve the Department of Human Services, the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services, the Department of Education and the Department of Corrections. Presented by Representative LOVETT of Scarborough; Cosponsored by Senator MITCHELL of Penobscot and Representatives: BRAGDON of Bangor, BRENNAN of Portland, BROOKS of Winterport, KANE of Saco, QUINT of Portland, SNOWE-MELLO of Poland, Senator PARADIS of Aroostook. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. Public Hearing 02/03/99. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 02/08/00.
