An Act to Eliminate the Minimum Quota Requirement for a Store to Have a Lottery Machine. Presented by Representative CLARK of Millinocket; Cosponsored by Senator LIBBY of York and Representatives: AHEARNE of Madawaska, GOODWIN of Pembroke, JACOBS of Turner, MAYO of Bath, O'NEAL of Limestone, POVICH of Ellsworth, USHER of Westbrook, Senator MICHAUD of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 01/28/99. House: Minority (OTP-AM) Accepted 05/18/99, Conference Committee 05/21/99. Senate: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 05/20/99, Adhere to Majority (ONTP) 05/21/99. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 05/21/99.
