An Act to Require Insurance Companies to Notify the Secretary of State When the Insurance on a Registered Vehicle has Lapsed. Presented by Representative MacDOUGALL of North Berwick; Cosponsored by Senator MacKINNON of York and Representatives: PINKHAM of Lamoine, GLYNN of South Portland, LEMONT of Kittery, MACK of Standish, SNOWE-MELLO of Poland, WHEELER of Eliot, Senator LIBBY of York. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. Public Hearing 02/01/99. Final Disposition: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 03/03/99.
