LD 403 / HP0295

An Act to Allow a One-time Double Exemption for Income Tax Filers Who Adopt a Dependent Child. Presented by Representative WILLIAMS of Orono; Cosponsored by Senator MURRAY of Penobscot and Representatives: BOLDUC of Auburn, BRAGDON of Bangor, CHIZMAR of Lisbon, GAGNON of Waterville, TESSIER of Fairfield. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 02/10/99. House: Insist on Majority (OTP-AM) 04/29/99, Conference Committee 04/29/99, Unable to Agree 05/25/99. Senate: Insist on Minority (ONTP) 05/03/99, Conference Committee 05/03/99, Unable to Agree 05/25/99. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 05/25/99.
