An Act to Extend Term Limits for Elected Officials and Constitutional Officers. Presented by Senator MILLS of Somerset; Cosponsored by Senator DAGGETT of Kennebec, Representatives: HATCH of Skowhegan, THOMPSON of Naples, TUTTLE of Sanford. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 03/18/99. Final Disposition: Died in Concurrence 06/18/99.
