An Act to Require Notice to Abutters Prior to Commercial Applications of Pesticides. Presented by Representative BULL of Freeport; Cosponsored by Representatives: GAGNE of Buckfield, McKEE of Wayne, MUSE of South Portland, SULLIVAN of Biddeford, Senators: ABROMSON of Cumberland, PINGREE of Knox, TREAT of Kennebec. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. Public Hearing 04/07/99. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 05/05/99.
