An Act to Require High School Students to Earn a Certificate of Mastery Before Graduating. Presented by Senator AMERO of Cumberland; Cosponsored by Representative MURPHY of Kennebunk and Senators: ABROMSON of Cumberland, BENNETT of Oxford, MacKINNON of York, MILLS of Somerset, Representative CIANCHETTE of South Portland. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. Public Hearing 03/24/99. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 02/08/00.
