An Act to Ban Partial Birth Abortion. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 04/15/99. House: Minority (OTP-AM) Accepted 05/20/99, Adhere to Minority (OTP-AM) 05/20/99. Senate: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 05/20/99, Adhere to Majority (ONTP) 05/21/99. Died Between Houses 05/21/99. Final Disposition: Failed in Referendum 11/02/99 (In favor: 185,541; Opposed: 232,113).
