An Act to Make More Uniform the Training of Firefighters. Presented by Senator RUHLIN of Penobscot; Cosponsored by Representative BERRY of Livermore and Senators: MICHAUD of Penobscot, O'GARA of Cumberland, PARADIS of Aroostook, Representatives: BULL of Freeport, PERKINS of Penobscot, USHER of Westbrook. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice. Public Hearing 04/07/99. OTP-AM Accepted 05/06/99. Amended by: CA S-194. Enacted, 06/03/99. Vetoed by Governor 06/15/99. Final Disposition: Veto Sustained 06/18/99.
