An Act to Increase the Maximum Benefit Levels Provided for Injured Workers. Presented by Representative HATCH of Skowhegan; Cosponsored by Senator CATHCART of Penobscot and Representatives: BAGLEY of Machias, BRYANT of Dixfield, GOODWIN of Pembroke, SAMSON of Jay. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Labor. Public Hearing 04/08/99. Majority (OTP-AM) Accepted 05/26/99. Amended by: CA H-548. Enacted 06/03/99. Vetoed by Governor 06/15/99. Final Disposition: Veto Sustained 06/18/99.
