Resolve, That the Director of the Maine State Museum Shall Include the Portraits of Outstanding Indians in the State House. Presented by Representative SOCTOMAH of the Passamaquoddy Tribe; Cosponsored by Representatives: HATCH of Skowhegan, LORING of the Penobscot Nation, MAYO of Bath, McKEE of Wayne, SCHNEIDER of Durham, Senator LAWRENCE of York. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. Public Hearing 04/07/99. OTP-AM Accepted 05/05/99. Amended by: CA H-325. Final Disposition: Finally Passed, Signed 05/20/99, RESOLVE LAWS, Chapter 40.
