An Act to Create Standards of Eligibility Governing Certain Tax-exempt Organizations and to Phase in a Reduction of the Rate of Exemption to Reflect the Cost of Providing Essential Municipal Services. Presented by Senator DAGGETT of Kennebec; Cosponsored by Senators: CATHCART of Penobscot, MILLS of Somerset, RAND of Cumberland, Representative SAXL of Bangor. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 04/12/99. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 02/08/00.
