An Act to Ensure the Availability of Funds for Tobacco Prevention and Control. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Senator RUHLIN of Penobscot; Cosponsored by Representative MATTHEWS of Winslow and Senators: CATHCART of Penobscot, PARADIS of Aroostook, Representatives: COLWELL of Gardiner, GREEN of Monmouth, LOVETT of Scarborough. Referred jointly to Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services and Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. Public Hearing 04/28/99. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 05/24/99.
