Presented by Representative ROWE of Portland; Cosponsored by Senator PARADIS of Aroostook and Representatives: BRAGDON of Bangor, BROOKS of Winterport, FULLER of Manchester, KANE of Saco, QUINT of Portland, SAXL of Portland, Senator MITCHELL of Penobscot. Referred jointly to Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services and Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. Public Hearing 04/28/99. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 05/24/99.
