Resolve, to Require the Department of Transportation to Build a Truck Escape Ramp on Route 16 in Bingham. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative MCGLOCKLIN of Embden; Cosponsored by Senator MILLS of Somerset and Representatives: DUGAY of Cherryfield, FISHER of Brewer, FULLER of Manchester, GILLIS of Danforth, SHIAH of Bowdoinham, TRAHAN of Waldoboro. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. Public Hearing 04/28/99. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 02/08/00.
