An Act to Allow the Cumberland County Domestic Violence Unit to Hire 2 New Assistant District Attorneys Immediately. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Senator HARRIMAN of Cumberland; Cosponsored by Representative SAXL of Portland and Senators: ABROMSON of Cumberland, AMERO of Cumberland, RAND of Cumberland, Representatives: BRENNAN of Portland, BRUNO of Raymond, ROWE of Portland.
