An Act to Protect Medicaid Recipients and Providers from Unintended Consequences of the Noncompliance of the Department of Human Services with Year 2000 Readiness. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative GLYNN of South Portland; Cosponsored by Senator MICHAUD of Penobscot and Representatives: BRAGDON of Bangor, BROOKS of Winterport, MacDOUGALL of North Berwick, MACK of Standish, SHIELDS of Auburn, SNOWE-MELLO of Poland, Senators: LIBBY of York, MITCHELL of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services. No Public Hearing. Final Disposition: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 06/01/99.
