LD 2422 / HP1716

RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Allow the Legislature to Provide for Assessment of Property Used for Commercial Fishing at Current Use. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative ETNIER of Harpswell; Cosponsored by Senator PINGREE of Knox and Representatives: GREEN of Monmouth, HONEY of Boothbay, LEMONT of Kittery, LINDAHL of Northport, PERKINS of Penobscot, POWERS of Rockport, Senators: GOLDTHWAIT of Hancock, MacKINNON of York. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 02/03/00. OTP-AM Accepted 03/07/00. Amended by: CA H-820. Finally Passed, Signed 04/04/00, CON RES LAWS, Chapter 4. Final Disposition: Failed in Referendum 11/07/00 (In favor: 301,393; Opposed: 305,554).
